International Beethoven Competition for Piano in Bonn 2005

- 3rd prize

Just twenty years old, the pianist David Kadouch impresses the audience by his characteristic playing. In December 2005, David Kadouch won third prize at the 1st International Beethoven Competition Bonn, presented by the Deutschen Telekom AG – a phantastic career start for the young artist.

He has already performed in some of the most renowned concert halls of the world: Moscow's Bolshoi Hall, Carnegie Hall in New York and Théâtre du Châtelet in Paris, to name but a few. He is also a welcome guest at famous festivals: He played under Pierre Boulez at the Lucerne Festival in 2004, and in summer of 2006, he will perform at the Klavierfestival Ruhr and the International Festival of Santander, Spain.

David Kadouch began his training at the Nice Conservatory. At thirteen, he won the Young Talents Competition in Milan, and in 2005 he was awarded the prize of the best pianist at the International Summer Academy Mozarteum in Salzburg. Despite his early successes, he then continued his studies at the Paris Superior Conservatory and is currently in Dimitri Bashkirov's class at the Reina Sofía School in Madrid.
