She has been a scholarship student of the Japanese Rohm Music Foundation since 2005. In June 2003 she was a guest at the Wilhelm Kempff Foundation in Positano, Italy. Keiko Hattori has already won several renowned competition prizes, including first prize in all categories (solo piano, song duo and chamber music) at the 17th International Schubert Competition 2004 in Italy. In 2004 she established the Pamina Trio (piano, clarinet, violin) with which she is also a multiple international prize winner.
